KCCB Shelter Reservation Rules

The Kossuth County Conservation Board shelter houses are available to the public to utilize either by reservation or on a first come – first served basis. Reservations have priority. The reservation fee is \$25.00 per day. Shelter houses may be reserved for the following areas: Smith Lake Park, Siems Park, and Michealsen Marsh. The shelter houses are available between the hours of 6:00 am and 10:00 pm, April 15th through October 31st. Reservations must be made at least seven days in advance with the user fee paid at that time.
